## **Congregational Connections Grant ~ Evaluation**

### GRANT REQUIREMENTS:

Grantees must submit a progress report on how the grant activities no later than March 31, 2016. If your program plans change, please indicate that on your written report that also includes responses to the questions below. A site visit of your program by an Acts In Common Board Director must be done prior to submitting an application for future funding. Call if you have an event scheduled to arrange a visit.

### Evaluative Questions:

1. What did you do?  
Describe your program. What were the activities?
2. How many people participated?  
How many were youth (under 18), young adult (19-35), adult (36-64), or senior adult (65+)?
3. How often? What was the frequency of this program? When did it start? Has it ended? Was this a one-time event or held on a regular schedule?
4. What were the program expectations? Where they met? How would you rate this program on a scale from 1 to 10, with 1 being poor and 10 being excellent? Did this year's program perform as expected?
5. What would you change or do differently next year?
6. Are there ways you can make adjustments to the program that would increase participation and/or the opportunities provided?
7. Who runs this program/project?  
Are the volunteers from the church or community?  
Are there any community partners? If so, what is their role?
8. How can this program/project be supported by the other Lutheran congregations of Acts InCommon? Can other churches participate? Are they invited?
9. How can this program/project benefit Acts InCommon?
10. What kind of help or assistance would you request if you could ask without limits? (What's your dream for this program/project?)
